Riding Program

• **Group Lessons:**

Fees are paid on a trimester calendar. 60-minute group lessons (\$78.75 per lesson), \$945.00.
(Lessons not in a program are \$85)

• **Private Lessons**

Fees are paid on a trimester calendar 30-minute private lessons (\$78.75 per person), \$945
(Lessons not in a program are \$85)

Each trimester is 12 lessons. The lessons must be completed within the 12-week period. We will work with you to fit in make-up lessons. It is the parents'/guardians' responsibility to arrange make-up lessons. When cancellations are due to the weather, the farm will contact you for make-up lessons. If students riding more than 1x per week, multiply trimester price by the number of days riding. **IF WE CASH YOUR CHECK YOU ARE CONFIRMED.** We will let you know via email your date and time. **Barn is closed on Fridays**

Winter and Spring session has an extra week for snow days, We might cancel a day. You will not need a make up

Trimester dates:

Lessons will be given every week. If you take additional lessons during or in between trimesters, the cost will be billed accordingly. **All lessons will NOT need to schedule an extra day during the September barn closure or the 13-week winter session due to Christmas barn closure they have been built in.

We will do our best to accommodate everyone. Riding days and times are allotted on a first-come, first-served basis and riding level so that each student can benefit the most from their lesson.

- All riders must wear a properly fitting helmet, boots with a heel, and long pants. We do recognize riding is an expensive sport and children grow quickly. We have a small exchange program for riding apparel that students have outgrown and a few pairs of boots at the barn that may be borrowed. (Riders will NOT be permitted to ride in shorts or sneakers) Initials _____
- Riders should allow 15 minutes before and after their lessons to help tack up, untack, and groom the horse. Initials _____
- **We ask that you provide 24 hours' notice for any lesson which will be missed** so that we can plan accordingly. Lessonsthat are not canceled with reasonable notice will not be made up. It is the parents'/guardians' responsibility to schedule make-up lessons. This rule will be strictly enforced. Initials _____
- Lessons include ring work, occasional trail riding, ground horsemanship, medical and barn lessons. We have lessons rain orshine. If we cannot ride due to cold, wind, or extenuating weather conditions, unmounted instruction will be given indoors. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Initials _____
- NO JEANS in English saddles. Yoga pants or proper riding pants only, unless you use your own saddle that has been approved by management. Initials _____
